Day 1

The Royal Livingstone, Victoria Falls, Zambia

Enjoy a last morning game drive and scrumptious breakfast before transferring to Nelspruit Airport for our scheduled flight to Livingstone Airport, Zambia. After a short road transfer to a jetty, we take a private boat trip to the Sundeck at the luxurious Royal Livingstone.

After settling in and enjoying afternoon tea or a cocktail, we depart for the ultimate sunset river safari cruise. The first part of the cruise is done at a leisurely pace through the various channels between the islands. After stopping at one of the islands for snacks and drinks, we continue upstream on the Zimbabwe side of Siloka Island where we meets one of the boats of the African Cruise Company. On the African Queen/Princess you will be taken to your reserved table where you will enjoy the African sunset on the Mighty Zambezi River. The boats meander approximately two miles upstream along the length of the Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park treating you to sophisticated views of the Zambezi River and the surrounding game reserves. Upon returning to the hotel the evening is at your leisure.

Day 2

The Royal Livingstone, Victoria Falls, Zambia

After a magical night’s sleep and fabulous breakfast, our second day starts with a private guided tour of the Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. Mosi-Oa-Tunya - the Smoke that Thunders. At 5,604 feet wide, it is the largest curtain of water in the world that drops 338 feet into the basalt depths of the sheer Zambezi Gorge. To truly appreciate the Falls, we explore both the Zambian and Zimbabwean sides.

Returning to the hotel, the rest of the day is yours to indulge in numerous activities. If your idea of activity is doing absolutely nothing at all, then any one of the hammocks dotted alongside the river are sure to catch your fancy, or you could laze by the pool right on the banks of the Zambezi River with breath-taking views and a cocktail. You may even see the resident zebras grazing by the pool.

At some point today the Royal Spa awaits you - relax in exquisite tents and in the shade of ancient trees, and feel time slip by with a Swedish massage.
